

The weather was mild and it served to make people more laid back and receptive to conversations about Jesus Christ. Beth did street ministry and daily was able to talk to a variety of folks. Most bikers do not come to the rallies thinking about spiritual things but that is what the ministries, especially Christian Riders, are there for. Bikers for Babies

August 26 took Beth to Martinsville, VA for the 6th Annual "Bikers for Babies" Run. Patrick and Patsy Rusmisl, Jesus Christ Ambassadors Motorcycle Ministry along with New Life Community Church heads up this run each year to benefit the Pregnancy Care Center of Henry County. This year about 67 motorcycles raised \$7,000 for the Center. We had the privilege of hearing one of the ladies who went through the center testify about her newborn son and her new faith in

Jesus Christ. It was a great day filled with riding, fellowship, witnessing, and food.

The police-escorted run began by meeting in downtown Martinsville and then proceeded for about 100 miles with one stop. God was truly with us this year as two bikes were involved in separate incidents within the pack but minimal damage to bikes and non to riders. God is good!

The bikers that came were from the local area as well as

We are proud of Patrick and Patsy and are blessed to have them in our sister ministry, the Ambassadors. It was evident a lot of work and planning went into this event to make it such a success. Let's keep shining for Jesus and standing up to help those in need.

Run for the Wall & Rolling Thunder

"Run for the Wall" is an organization that stages a ride from California to Washington D.C. yearly to draw attention to Veterans' issues and to ride for those who cannot. Once in D.C., they take part in "Rolling Thunder": a ride/parade of approx. 800,000 bikes through D.C. on Memorial Day Sunday. Beth has taken part in Rolling Thunder for 5 year but this year also joined the "Run for the Wall" in Chattanooga, TN on the Tuesday before Memorial weekend. Being DQ was a Viet Nam era veteran, this run is close to her heart. There are also many hurting men and women there who need the freedom only Jesus can offer.

Some of the group stops included laying a wreath at a Confederate Cemetery in Chattanooga as well as the WWII Memorial in Forest, Va. There was also stops at two different elementary schools where the bikers taught the children about patriotism. The children blessed us with an

assemblies filled with songs and readings. The bikers also gave out beads, flag pins and other trinkets to the kids. Beth had Christian toys available for them and, of course, the two Shelties drew the kids over to her. Some of the older chil-



dren even entrusted us with things to take to The Wall in D.C. Needless to say, it was quite a touching time.

Unfortunately, Beth's bike decided to die 2 miles from the end of the run. She had to be towed into the local dealership for a quick fix of the fuel pump housing. They did get the bike fixed in time for the Sunday Rolling Thunder Ride in

downtown D.C.

Spring weather made this a challenging run as daily we dealt with heavy rains. Riding in pouring rain in a pack of 874 bikes is challenging for the most experienced of riders.

Add to the fact that Beth was also camping along the way made for less than ideal conditions. But all this served to draw our platoon or group of 25 riders closer and Beth was able to share Jesus with many in the group.

"Riding, eating, camping-- just doing life together for a week draws you together." Beth explains. "I believe we often win the opportunity to share with someone. Sometimes that is best done by caring enough to have a relationship. People will accept something from someone they know quicker than from a stranger. It's great when I have the time in ministry to work on relationships."


the great Kingdom work He had for us. Often, we only looked at the short term, but GOD was forming for the long haul."


